Estate of the late Andrew R. Getty sells in Hollywood Hills West for \$6.1 million



sprawling Hollywood Hills villa where the late Andrew R. Getty, an heir to the Getty oil fortune, made his home for nearly two decades has sold for \$6.1 million.

Sitting on a hilltop overlooking the San Fernando Valley, the classic Spanish Revival estate is firmly rooted in Old Hollywood history. Hungarian-born composer and musician Miklos Rozsa, who won Oscars for his scoring of "Spellbound" (1945), "A Double Life: (1947) and "Ben-Hur" (1959), formerly owned the property for half a century.



Designed by John L. DeLario, the 1920s home retains its vintage good looks. Details of note include arched doors and windows, beamed ceilings and Saltillo tile floors. Artful tile risers and delicate stained glass create visual interest throughout the 4,712 square feet of interiors.
